Gentlemen,

Further to your request letter of 26-11-2004,
Regarding passports of "Dominion of Melchizedek" to be used by all citizens of your country
"Dominion of Melchizedek" (DOM), we are now in receipt of views of my Government on
your ideas about the use the passport of "Dominion of Melchizedek" as travel document for
International Identification.

Government of Belgium will always give cooperation and assistance to all citizens of
your country, by giving them special travel document (Visa) which have been accepted by
other countries. My Government believes that your idea is interesting and, providing all
requirements are complied with and security maintained, Belgium would accept such
documents for purposes of being used instead of a passport.

My Government believes that if your office (Embassy, Consulate) decides to open an
office in Belgium for legal and security reasons, you must include among the Directors of said
office a Representative of the Belgian Government from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

In summary, Belgium accept the passport of "Dominion of Melchizedek" as travel
document for personal identification.
